

# OUR **50** *year* HISTORY

## *Timeline*

The Sacramento Life Center was the fourth of now 4000 pregnancy resource clinics established across the country, one of the first in California to offer free ultrasounds, one of the few clinics that has a licensed and nationally accredited medical clinic and the first in California to offer a mobile medical clinic.

1972

Opened first office on Marconi Avenue and hired first paid staff.

Incorporated as the Sacramento Right to Life Committee, a 501c3, with a volunteer telephone hotline and Speaker's Bureau.

1978

Donors purchased a home on X Street to serve as a new office.



1982

1985

Right to Life changed name to Sacramento Life Center.



1992

Raised \$150,000 to establish a state licensed medical clinic located on J Street.

Held first annual Salute to Life Gala and Auction.

1996

1998

Sacramento Life Center's medical clinic began offering free onsite ultrasounds



Moved to larger facility on Alhambra Blvd.

2003

2010

Rolled out first of 2 Mobile Medical Clinics, serving sites throughout Sacramento region.

Began Men's Voice Project offering male peer counseling to dads.

Expanded our medical services to include pap smears, health checks and well-woman exams.

Began STD Testing and Treatment program.

Received national Accreditation from Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care, Inc.

Purchased & Renovated a 5,000+ sq. ft. medical building in the Arden Area.

Added Abortion Pill Reversal procedure for women who have started a medical abortion.

Raised \$220,000 to purchase new state-of-the-art Mobile Medical Clinic.


## CAPITAL CAMPAIGN IS COMPLETE


## NEW MOBILE MEDICAL CLINIC

Our new, customized Mobile Medical Clinic has arrived! We are thrilled to hire and train new staff, customize the wrap, purchase a new portable ultrasound machine, and begin to offer free services to women in underserved areas in the community. ## OUR SCHOLARSHIP FUND IS HELPING MOMS

We established The Connie Koppes and Pam Anderson Scholarship Fund awarding scholarships to deserving moms. No longer will our pregnant patients believe that their education and career goals are unreachable. This fund was seeded by the Rich and Connie Koppes and the Anderson family. Named after Connie, a founding board member and supporter, and Pam, a longtime volunteer who sadly passed away last year, this has been a dream of the Sacramento Life Center staff for a long time. So far, our scholarship program has helped one mom obtain her GED, another with medical assistance training, one mom began ultrasound tech training, and another continues with nursing school. We look forward to helping even more moms in 2023 obtain their dreams and be able to live life more abundantly!



# many blessings & accomplishments in 2022!



## EMERGENCY FUNDING FOR BASIC NEEDS

Our new Benevolent Fund Program helped many of our patients with emergency funding in 2022. With the cost of living constantly increasing, our moms are finding it difficult to make ends meet. With this new program we have been able to help them with rental assistance, food, gas, and utilities, in addition to ongoing baby supplies. Seventy-four percent of pregnancy terminations are due to financial stress. This fund is relieving that stress and helping our moms decide for life!

## PARENT EDUCATION ONLINE CLASSES ARE GROWING

We expanded our Parent Education Program! Over 500 parenting classes have been taken in our new on-line *BrightCourse* educational program. Thirty-five women have taken enough classes to receive a car seat or stroller, just in time for new baby to arrive. With these classes they are better prepared to take on their new parenting role.

## NEW MARKETING TO HELP WOMEN FIND US ONLINE

We started an online advertising campaign. Due to the censoring of pregnancy help by big tech companies like Google, Yelp and Facebook, this new advertising program has helped us maintain and even increase our patient numbers. It is so important that women know there is a safe place to go, to look carefully at ALL their options, and to find hope, compassion, and care for their personal situation.

## DIGNITY HEALTH GRANT HELPS US COLLABORATE

We are excited to receive a 2023 Dignity Health Community Grant with partners WellSpace Health and Women's Empowerment. With this collaboration we can offer additional hope to pregnant women who come to us; especially those without insurance or a doctor's care, are unemployed and may be suffering from homelessness, domestic violence, or drug abuse. Thank you Dignity Health!

# PATIENT SERVICES

For Fiscal Year 2022



In 2022 we had over 2,400 patient visits. providing FREE pregnancy testing, ultrasounds, resources, STD tests, men's mentoring, and well women exams. We provide services to anyone who comes through our door seeking help regardless of income, ethnicity or religion. No insurance is requested or required.

96% of our patients are low-income  
50% have no medical insurance  
24% are young adults under the age of 24  
10% are teenagers  
50% have previous children  
35% are immigrants




